MEETING

1. Open the meeting - Meeting opened at 7:03 p.m.
2. Review October minutes and approve - October meeting minutes were reviewed. Terry moved to approve seconded by Richard. Vote to approve was unanimous.
3. Flu clinic: results and evaluations -
 1. There are no final numbers yet, but attendance at the senior center was similar to last year and Mohawk's was less.
 2. Question raised whether the clinics are free. Richard explained that the state used to offer the vaccine for free, thus the clinics were free. Now FRCOG has to pay for the vaccine so must recoup that cost.
 3. Use of robocall was also brought into question, asking if BOH had to request permission for its use when the senior center does not. BOH did request permission from select board.
4. Vacant and abandoned housing; progress and update - Terry reported that he and Marti Ferguson met at town hall then proceeded to view properties. He updated Board on their findings. Most houses are in the names of banks making it difficult to get information regarding properties.
