Discussion of solarize programs past, present, & future including state/federal incentives for residents, businesses, and municipalities, community solar initiatives; moving forward with awarded META Grant for Community Shared Solar feasibility study and approved proposal from Northeast Solar (still in Phase 1)
 - META Grant for Community Shared Solar feasibility study update: Heather will contact Tom and Greg (Northeast Solar) for update on project, and discussing possibility of having phone conference with NES, Heather, and BEC members possibly at future BEC meeting; find out more effects re: COVID-related delays on META Grants (contacting Mark Rabinsky & DOER); still need to check on suitability/availability of land and/or roof at Town Garage site.
- 4. Discussion of local and regional energy-related issues, possibly including:
 - Rail transport of fossil and other fuels; concerns about derailments, remaining railroad ties and debris along tracks
 - State-proposed energy legislation, including proposed "woodlands partnership"; response to Northern Pass; PACE Program & Green Works

 - *MassSave program updates*
 - New Massachusetts programs: (through Mass CEC and DOER; Center for EcoTechnology --CET)

 - PFAS Testing Program updates
 - We'll each continue to research current status of energy programs and report back at the next meeting: CET (Ellen), DOER (Penny), CEC (Brian), META Action (Michael: tonight shared info about possibility of applying for grants to help with administering or applying for other grants), Mass Save (Margaret: since last meeting, put up link to MassSave on the Energy Committee website: showed the various tabs) Green Communities (Harvey: prior to meeting, emailed chart listing approx. \$271,000 Buckland has received in GCG since 2011)

 - EC members will think of possible projects for Spring '22 to discuss at next meeting
