- 3. Discussion of solarize programs past, present, & future including state/federal incentives for residents, businesses, and municipalities, community solar initiatives
  - Discussion about getting more information on "Relay Power".
    https://relaypower.com; discussion of community solar: municipal (e.g. Wendell) vs. corporate
- 4. Discussion of local and regional energy-related issues, including:
  - MCAP
  - Rail transport of fossil and other fuels; concerns about derailments, remaining railroad ties and debris along tracks
  - State-proposed energy legislation, including proposed "woodlands partnership"; response to Northern Pass
  - Alternative electric power suppliers; regional municipal electricity aggregation plan updates
  - MassSave program updates
  - New Massachusetts programs: (through Mass CEC and DOER; Center for EcoTechnology --CET)
  - Municipal lighting/streetlights
  - Recycle-able/biodegradable plastic bags; single-use plastics
    - ° No update on MCAP
    - ° Rail: Looks like PanAm is switching out a lot of ties: more piles, possibly of new ties going in; discussion of Pan Am's lack of communication/ notification to towns in general (interstate rail system)
    - ° Woodlands Partnership/ biomass: Discussed possibility of some Energy Committee members attending 10 July BOH meeting to learn more about their position on these topics; discussed possibility of BEC submitting statement to Mass DOER during comment period (necessity to clear any statement with Buckland Select Board before any submission as BEC is an appointed committee: if we draft statement at July meeting, submit to SB before their 23 July meeting); Biomass comment period extended to July 26 (Recorder article on 14 June Pages 1/8)
    - Ask Penny to follow up with Mass Save to see if program she mentioned applies to municipalities as well.

- ° Lighting: Make sure the Buckland SB, Heather have information on services that Jim Lowenthal may be able to provide (re: lighting design, environmental & health impacts); send 17 June Recorder article (p. A-4) about Jim Lowenthal's work to potentially interested parties.
- ° Plastics: no update on single-use plastics/plastic bags; Brian's photos of plastic and pipes along river (from dam pipe/wood/plastic barrier failures): discussed possibility of presenting slide show at future SB meeting re: the general plastic garbage plus debris from the dams visible along the river
- 5. Update on past Green Communities Grant applications; planning for 2020
  - continue discussion on potential projects to include in future applications, especially those that will bring us closer to the 20% reduction in energy use marker
