Buckland Finance Committee Minutes

April 15, 2019

Meeting called to order at Buckland Public Library 7:05 p.m.

Committee members present: Karen Blom, Ciara Hayden, Ben Murray, Larry Langford (joined remotely), Raymond Lanza-Weil, Paula Consolo (arrived 7:12 pm).

Others present: Bob Markel, interim town administrator; Dena Wilmore, selectboard; Marilyn Kelsey, community member.

Karen moves that we accept the revised minutes from April 8. Ben seconds. Unanimously approved.

Truck loan has been paid off, which was a \$12,000 annual expense, so we moved this amount plus \$3,000 for a total of \$15,000 into road repaving, since residents have made clear that keeping up our roads is a priority.

Highway will need to reduce the Upper St TIP project that came in at \$1.2 million down to \$1 million, which is the amount of the grant. The town can't afford \$200,000 out of any operating budget to pay the difference.

We need to add a warrant article to cover the Wastewater Treatment facility audit, which is a rollover account.

Recommend that the select board will divide the warrant into two warrants: one to call the town to vote and one for the town budget and result of elections.

As budget stands, tax rate at \$19.34 will rise by 71 cents, but Bob thinks it will be a little less. That's about \$140 more in property taxes for the average homeowner.
