## **MEETING**

- 1. Open the meeting John Gould opened the meeting at 6:39 p.m.
- 2. Discussion with Alyssa LaRose, FRCOG: Zoning Recommendations from Housing Survey -
  - 1. Board introduced themselves to Alyssa LaRose.
  - 2. Alyssa gave 2 handouts to board. (See attached)
    - 1. Buckland Housing Plan
      - 1. Recommendations and strategies specifically for Buckland.
    - 2. Zoning for Housing Strategies.
      - 1. Not town specific.
  - 3. Grant expires June 2019 but is possible to ask for extension
  - 4. Owner of Lamson-Goodnow property is not interested in using property for housing.
  - 5. What were recommendations for Buckland as result of survey? Brief board discussion.
  - 6. John Gould reported that the population of Buckland is shrinking so the use of exiting structures seems a more likely fit for Buckland than new construction.
  - 7. Also pointed out that new regulations on Airbnb's will help regulate accessory apartments.
  - 8. Discussions on lot sizes, conforming and non-conforming lots. Are there different set backs for accessory buildings as opposed to primary dwellings? Board discussion.
  - 9. Are two buildings on one lot the same as an accessory apartment? Would conversion of a barn to multiple apartments be acceptable? Brief discussion on both.

- 10. Petition can be made by small rural towns for different unit/acre ratio.
- 11. Board reviewed both handouts from Alyssa with particular attention to the one specific to Buckland. They noted recommendations most suitable to the town.
- 12. Michael asked if each approach requires an individual public hearing? He also pondered if, while Marijuana Bylaw is still in process, does Board have time to "full on" pursue both?
- 13. Alyssa's answer to first question was that though funding is good; timing is the issue. Board discussed time factor and need to pursue housing.
