**RESULTS OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
TOWN OF BUCKLAND,**

There were 118 Town of Buckland voters in attendance at the Special Town Meeting held at the Buckland Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:35m. Phoebe Walker, served in her capacity as Moderator working from a warrant dated December 31, 2015 and posted by Constable, Paul J. Herbert.

There was an explanation from John Riggan regarding the purchase of the Sears Street facility for a highway garage. Following discussion the following was voted.

ARTICLE 1: The Town voted and passed unanimously to purchase the parcel of land located at 2 Sears Street Extension, Buckland, containing 4.7 acres, more or less, and described in deeds recorded with the Franklin District Registry of Deeds in Book 1172, Pages 255 and 258, and, to authorize the Board of Selectmen to grant easements in, on and under said parcel of land for access and utility purposes, as the Board deems appropriate, and, further, to transfer from the General Stabilization Account \$325,000 to pay for the purchase.


The Board of Selectmen voted in favor of this article.
